
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THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA CONTEST CLUB MEETS ON THE FIRST

CLASSIFICATION OF CONTESTERS

THESE ARE SOME OF THE TYPES OF CONTESTERS. THERE MAY BE SOME MORE, BUT THIS IS A START. WHICH OF THE FOLLOWING FITS YOU?

THE "A" CATEGORY (CONTEST CRIPPLE)

THIS IS THE GUY WHO EATS, SLEEPS, AND DRINKS HAM RADIO. HE SCHEDULES HIS WHOLE LIFE AROUND THE CONTEST CALENDAR, AND CAN RECITE THE TOP TEN FROM EVERY SWEEPSTAKES SINCE PHIL WON IT AT WARW IN 1969.
