As announced at the October club meeting, the SCCC selected Ken Widelitz, K6LA, to represent the club at the World Radiosport Team Championship (WRTC) in Slovenia in July 2000. According to the WRTC rules, Ken will need to select a teammate who is a U.S. citizen and who is not currently a member of the SCCC.

NAQP Changes

Several important changes have been made in the NAQP rules effective with the January 2000 CW and SSB contests. Maximum output power has been reduced to 100W, and the use of external amplifiers capable of more than 100 watts output is not allowed.
